

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK BY FR. OWEN KORTE

HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC PARISHES MISSION: MARCH 10-12, 2024. 40 Hours like last year. Three evening services in three locations in our family. Fr. Taylor Leffler will come and preach this mission.

PETITION DRIVE: The petition drive is still going on to put on the ballot a constitutional amendment that would make abortion from conception all the way up to birth a right. No limits, babies can be killed at 9 months with no consequences. It advertises itself as a protection for women. Do not be deceived. This amendment would even take away a parents rights over their dependent children who might want an abortion. **DECLINE TO SIGN.**

DEACON INTEREST: Following up on the homilies delivered by Deacon Tim McNeil over the past several weekends at our Weekend Masses, we have scheduled an information meeting to continue the discussion. Sunday, Feb. 25, 4pm, Randolph Church Basement. Includes refreshments and food. We'll eat after we meet.

UPGRADE THE RELIGIOUS ED CLASSROOMS AT ST. Ask A Priest - With Fr Korte

Question: I am struggling with the recent declaration by Pope Francis. I know that the Pope can err, he is human, I feel that the Fiducia Supplicans produces confusion in the church. The main reason I feel this way, is the closeness the Pope has had with Fr. James Martin, and Fr. Martin's total disregard for what the Pope..had said in the declaration. Makes one wonder what the Pope is after with the declaration. Why have Priests been defrocked, Fr. Frank Pavone, who stands up for the voiceless, yet defends Fr. Martin who goes against Catholic dogma.

I realize we must love the sinner, hate the sin. Everyone gets caught up in whether or not we can judge someone, the fact is we can judge when someone is doing something wrong. I rattled on a lot, but my question is, what do we do when all these near heretical statements are happening? It is tough enough with society today to teach our children right from wrong, and now the church is appearing to say that wrong is right.

Answer: There's a lot to unpack here. I too have been perplexed by this document that came from the Dicastery (Office) for the Doctrine of the Faith. Fiducia Supplicans was about blessings that can be given to those who are living contrary to the teachings of the Church on sexuality, especially those in a gay or homosexual genital relationship. Confusion is what it produced. It was not a good teaching. For a document that said it would not have any further clarification or any suggestions for actual blessing formulas, after much world-wide blowback, a clarification and a suggested blessing formula was offered by the Dicastery. The Bishops of Africa, a part of the Catholic Church that compromises 30% of Catholics world wide, said they would NOT offer such blessings and their priests were instructed to not participate in such a simulation. Fr. Vogel and I preached about this subject in our homilies on the Feast of the Holy Family. I acknowledge the pain on the part of the parents in our parishes who have children who are gay or even married to their gay partner. These people deserve our love and prayers. I have known good people who are gay and even though we can disagree on this intimate matter, I can still pray for them and listen to them. I have never been asked by a couple whose marriage is not recognized by the Church (2nd marriage without an annulment) to have their marriage blest. I would ask to work with them to help them find a way for their marriage to be rectified. Two people of the same sex, living together, helping each other, but in a non-physical relationship...we used to call that friendship. I can pray for people so they can live chaste and holy lives; it's what I would pray for with an engaged couple. Unfortunately in our world, there are no limits on sexual expression anymore. Anything and everything has to be allowed because I say so, my desires are what matters. In addition, all of this circles around our need for love and companionship and I can understand that as a powerful factor too. I'm sorry that the document failed to say anything about living a virtuous chaste life. In the life of the church we too often get documents from Rome that are simply confusing as best. Often these documents are put on a shelf where they gather dust and are ignored. This is one of them. As for Fr. Frank Pavone—my hunch it was a serious issue having little to do directly with prolife. And as for Fr. Martin....well let me put it this way, I'm not on his cheering squad. Pope Francis is in the later years of his pontificate; and mostly he has little to do with my everyday parish life. We have seen this before in the history of our Church. We continue to pray for the Pope; He is Peter and by praying for Him we help keep the ship of the Church from sinking. It has always taken on water, the storms have always battered this baroque. The Holy Spirit will have His way but not in the way we always want. It is my Church and over the years I have seen a lot; I remain, because it is my Church. There's too much good in the Church for me to jump ship; the good far outweighs Fiducia Supplicans.


